Who does Jesus say He will love and reveal Himself to? "*Those who accept my commandments and <u>obey</u> them are the ones who love me. And <u>because</u> they love me, my Father will love them. And I will love them and reveal myself to each of them." (John 14:21 NLT). So it's by obeying that we get closer to God. Therefore:*

Learn God says if you want his blessing you need to do the following four underlines in James 1:25 (NIV) "But whoever <u>looks intently</u> into the perfect law that gives freedom, and <u>continues in it</u>—<u>not forgetting</u> what they have heard, <u>but doing it</u>—they will be blessed in what they do." So while slowly reading:

- 1. Ask God "Am I doing this?" as you read each paragraph (Luke 6:46). It may be: sins to avoid, promises to rely on, examples to follow or not follow, commands to obey, or knowledge to live by. Some underline these. Talk with God about what you are reading. Ask Him for help.
- 2. **Circle the promises** (both positive and negative ones) and underline it's condition. (most promises have a condition).
- 3. **Highlight what you want to remember** so you can quickly review it. This is key because if you forget it you can't do it! Some highlight key phrases instead of whole paragraphs.

Obey Jesus said "When you obey my commandments, you remain in my love" (John 15:10 NLT) so each day:

- 4. **Ask God which** highlight to focus on obeying today. Put a Star next to it. Write down (in Bible or journal) how the verse impressed you and how you will do it. Some write it as a prayer.
- 5. **Think throughout the day** on what you wrote and read (Psalm 1.2). A great way to do this is to talk about it with your friends.
