BULLETIN: Black Men Listen

This is a CULTURAL BULLETIN AND CREED aimed at young black men, particularly those who've amassed significant wealth or riches [I.E., NBA PLAYERS, NFL PLAYERS, MLB PLAYERS, GOLF PROFESSIONALS, MUSICIANS, OTHER ENTERTAINERS, ACTORS, BUSINESS MEN, ENTREPRENEURS, DOCTORS, LAWYERS, HEIRS, and so on]. If we can't effectively build intellectual and financial wealth through other auspiciousdetermined black men, who've the aptitude, fitness, and liberty to further leverage that wealth through other less fortunate black men, particularly in ways wherein the strategy becomes aggressively cyclical, then black men, due to uncountable inequities entrenched in disproportionate systems of global free enterprise, legal systems, and social justice environments, our own lack of astute collective foresight will force us to become casualties of it all. In closing, this is not a message of division, particularly given the dire circumstances of black men, but one of perpetual unity, and through a strong desire for independence, this bulletin and creed champions the preservation of existence for all good humanity. In closing, black men, be brave, tenacious, and unapologetic in your efforts to level an uneven, hypocritical playing field.
