#### 1. Call to Order and Introductions

Chair Michael Bryce called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. TAC members, guests and SEAGO staff introduced themselves.

#### 2. Call to the Public

Chairman Bryce made a Call to the Public and no one spoke.

#### 3. Approval of Minutes of May 16, 2019 Meeting Minutes

Chairman Bryce asked for a motion to approve the May 16, 2019 Minutes.

#### 4. STP Ledger Report

Jim Russell presented the STBG Ledger Report that was included in the TAC packet on page 6. There were no changes to report.

#### 5. TIP Report

Jim referred the TAC to the TIP report beginning on page 7 of their packet. Jim advised that we had one TIP Amendment Request. The request was from the City of Nogales. Jim provided the following information concerning the request:

**NOG 19-02 – Nogales (Bankerd Ave. Paving Project):** The City of Nogales has requested that this project be cancelledand removed from the 2020-2014 TIP. After reviewing the budgeted amount of \$47,000 for the design portion of the project. It was determined that this amount would be insufficient and therefore the cost estimate to support the project exceeds the total programmed amount. After presenting the numbers to the Mayor and Council, they have decided to cancel the project and possibly reallocate the funds to the next CMAQ project on the list (Bicycle/Pedestrian Pathway on Grand Avenue, north of Baffert Drive). Jim informed the

membership that he had a letter the day before the TAC meeting from the City of Nogales requesting the project be removed from the TIP. If approved, this project will be removed from the current TIP and will need to be removed administratively from the 2020 TIP.

Chairman Bryce asked for a motion to approve the SEAGO TIP Amendment #4. Mark Hoffman indicated that this actually would not be Amendment #4 as the FHWA has not approved the prior submission. We simply need to remove this item from the TIP and resubmit for FHWA review.

**ACTION: APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY** 

#### 6. Presentation by ADOT on Traffic Data Management System.

The meeting was ahead of schedule so a video presentation was provided to the TAC regarding Public Involvement while Jim connected the WebEx presentation.

Jim attempted to connect to the presentation and discovered the presenter was in a different time zone, failed to adjust his time to be ready for the TAC, and was already in another meeting. Adam Lankford and Jothan Samuelson from Works Consulting (providing original installation and training for the MS2 software) was attending the TAC to assist in answering questions during the presentation. Adam and Jothan stepped in and provided an explanation of the software capabilities and entering traffic count data.

A discussion ensued regarding the traffic count data and need for regularity of collection. Most of the TAC members indicated they would appreciate more training on the process. Adam noted that the training would be most beneficial if tailored to the specific collectors used in each city. Jim volunteered to gather brands from each member and combine the training efforts to the collector brand rather than Adam and Jothan conducting 20 training sessions. Jothan requested with the gathering of information, it would be helpful if they also knew who is using traffic cameras and short term collectors. Members agreed to send the brand used in their city to Jim.

#### 7. Arizona Local Public Agency Stakeholder Council Meeting Reminder

Chairman Bryce introduced the Stakeholder meeting. Jennifer Henderson handed out a pamphlet the Every Day Counts Arizona initiative. Guidelines have been created with this initiative as well as a short presentation that can be used for groups if requested. If someone has an interest in being a local representative, please let Jennifer know.

Chairman Bryce expressed his thoughts on the 3-D demonstration and indicated he would like to learn more about the process. Randy Heiss informed the group that 3-D design will be a break out session for the Rural Transportation Summit.

#### 8. District Engineers' Report

No report - The Southeast and Southcentral District Engineers nor staff were available to attend this meeting.

#### 9. Regional Local Program Reports

Those in attendance reported their current status of local projects and issues.

**Willcox** reported that they are working on their Crash Count data.

**Benson** reported that Villages at Vigneto may or may not happen. Still a lot of controversy surrounding it.

**Santa Cruz** reported that the Rio Road/Pendelton will finish next month. The Board of Supervisors have approved the ROW and 30 miles of chip sealing has been done.

**Graham** reported that the round-a-bout bids are due August 2.

**Mark** reported Safford US 70 / I-10 study is underway. Identifying diversion of traffic to Safford if I-10 is closed, and provide for safety to the traffic flow and community.

**Jennifer** reported that the Huachuca project will go to the public for comments and then to the Council. The Thatcher Church Street project – bids are in and being reviewed. Sierra Vista IGA was active July 16<sup>th</sup>.

**Rudy Perez** reported that ADOT is expecting to make a call for Out of System Bridge projects in December. Clifton will be submitting the Chase Creek Bridge project for consideration.

Randy Petty reported that there is confusion for the 20<sup>th</sup> Street project in that the construction has been broken out into two phases and he doesn't know why. Discussion ensued with speculation on why, but no one knew for sure. Jim was tasked to research and find funding to complete the project.

**Tom** reported the Church Street project received 4 bids ranging from \$2.54 million to \$3.4 million. The project is ready to start.

Marv reported that San Carlos is essentially done and they are looking at drainage issues.

#### 10. Items for General Discussion

Chairman Bryce asked if anyone had items for general discussion.

Randy Heiss stated that the Santa Cruz RTA study will start the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of this fiscal year.

He also plugged the Rural Transit Summit, discussing the tracs and breakout sessions scheduled. Reminded members if they haven't registered yet, the block of rooms at the Casino Del Sol are running out.

**Michelle** AZ League of Cities and Towns will be coming. Also discussed the census impact on the region with funding levels dependent on the population numbers that are collected.

RE: SEAGO 2020-2024 TIP Project Request

After conducting research, SEAGO is requesting changes to the following project to the 2020-2024 TIP:

SAF 12-02 20<sup>TH</sup> Ave, Phase II and Phase III: SEAGO was tasked to determine the reason the construction phase for the 20<sup>th</sup> Ave project was broken into two phases. After researching TAC minutes and reviewing/comparing approved TIPs, there was no clear evidence or trail that clearly defines a distinctive action to separate. However, the Phase III appeared with an additional \$1.3 million for the project. It seems the cost of construction increased by that amount and the Phase III was added, though no funding was identified for the additional cost.

The construction cannot be broken into separate phases, therefore an Administrative Amendment was requested to combine both Phases and increase the total cost to \$3,538,706. This notes that an additional \$1.3 million will be needed to complete the funding identification for the project.

This project has been combined into one phase in the current TIP.

RE: SEAGO 2020-2024 TIP Project Request

SEAGO has received the following request to add a project to the 2020-2024 TIP:

**Willcox Bisbee Ave. Repaving Project:** The City of Willcox has submitted a project request for the Bisbee Ave. Repaving Project. The project will cover 3,025 feet (0.57 miles) starting at 729 Bisbee Ave and ending at 165 S. Bisbee Ave. The anticipated cost of the project is \$774,683 at a 5.7% match.

Bisbee Ave is failing with numerous potholes and an overall uneven surface. The uneven surface is causing trip hazards for pedestrians and the crosswalks are not ADA compliant. Bisbee Ave is a main route from the South side of town and a collector from Airport Road. This project would provide residents with a safer access to Willcox High School, Willcox Middle School, Keiler Park, and the residences along Bisbee Ave. as there is major foot traffic from students and families crossing Bisbee Ave to the schools, parks, and swimming pool. If approved, this project will be added to the current TIP.
