


Spending facts are average annual dollars per household














TAPESTRY SEGMENTATION COMPOSITION


INCOME AND NET WORTH


Net worth measures total household assets (homes, vehicles, investments, etc.) less any debts, secured (e.g, mortgages) or unsecured (credit cards) for this area.



AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD BUDGET INDEX



DIVERSITY

The Diversity Index summarizes racial and ethnic diversity. The index shows the likelihood that two persons, chosen at random from the same area, belong to different race or ethnic groups. The index ranges from 0 (no diversity) to 100 (complete diversity).






