








TAPESTRY SEGMENTATION COMPOSITION




INCOME AND NET WORTH


Net worth measures total household assets (homes, vehicles, investments, etc.) less any debts, secured (e.g, mortgages) or unsecured (credit cards) for this area.



AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD BUDGET INDEX

The index compares the average amount spent in this market's household budgets for housing, food, apparel, etc., to the average amount spent by all US households. An index of 100 is average. DIVERSITY














