QUESTIONS & RESPONSES

Q1. How can I find the bid document and submit a bid?

All bids must be received by September 16, 2025 at 3 p.m. for selection consideration.

Q2. Where can the American Iron and Steel Materials and De Minimis worksheet be found in the Bid Document? The proposal checklist on page7 it says the worksheet is on page 61, but that page is part of the LS-3 form and then it goes into certified payroll.

A2. With apologies, please see Page 38 in the Bid Document published to the SEAGO website (https://www.keepandshare.com/doc12/259236/wifa-sweet-springs-cmty-mhp-020-2025-bid-doc-rev4-pdf-17-7-meg?da=y) concurrent with the Bid Advertisement, which had a first print publication date of August 22, 2025.

Q3. When is the Bid Walk?

A3. The optional Site Inspection ('Bid Walk') was scheduled and held on Friday, September 5th at 10 a.m. per the Bid Document and Bid Advertisements published in the Herald/Review and Daily Territorial on August 22nd and August 29th, 2025.

Q4. When is the deadline for questions?

A4. Monday, September 15th, 2025 at 10 a.m., in order to allow for responses prior to the Bid Opening.

Q5. Can the property owner do work on this project?

A5. No, per A.R.S. 32-1121.05 the property owner is not a licensed contractor with the Arizona Registrar of Contractors (AZROC). Even if the property owner was licensed, A.R.S. 32-1121.06 also requires non-owners do work on a property for which owners receive rents as is the case here. ALL work must be completed for this project by AZROC contractors, selected by the awarded AZROC-licensed contractor or subcontractor thereof as appropriate to work requiring a different specialization license.

Q6. Can a potentially bidding contractor schedule another site visit with an electrical contractor prior to the Bid Submittal Deadline to assess the existing electrical situation and work needed?

A6. Yes, this is a reasonably expected request.

Q7. Can bids be submitted prior to the deadline by hand-delivery to SEAGO?

A7. Yes.
