#### Must List Amiliations.

He explained that army officers are required to list their affiliations with political organizations and other groups. If they have falsified the records their commissions are revoked. They also are liable to prosecution under the "fraud upon the government " statute which provides a maximum fine of \$10,000 and 10 years' imprisonment for false 50 Minute Delay of 'L' statements to the government.

The army's policy against Communists is a reversal of war time practice under which Communists were permitted to Join the army and obtain commissions, but were restricted officially to activities where they would learn no military secrets.
