



A NEW LOOK AT AN OLD FRIEND—This strange object is an old friend, snapped from a new angle. It's the 14,408-foot peak of Mt. Rainier, Washington, photographed by automatic camera from a Boeing B-29 Superfortress flying at 31,000 feet. One of the first vertical aerial views of the famous mountain, the picture above is a mosaic of four separate negatives. Boeing test pilots regularly use the snowy peak as a check point on their stratosphere flights.
