### Biological Standard Work Is Resumed

GENEVA, Switzerland—(AP)—International work on biological of American Military Government standardization started by the League of Nations more than a decade ago and interrupted by the war, has been resumed by the World Health Organization's expert committee on biological standardization.

Under the chairmanship of Dr. W. A. Timmerman of Utrecht, director of the Netherlands National Institute of Health, the committee met here recently and approved the emergency measures taken during the war by the Medical Research Institute of Hampstead, England.
