Read: 1 Samuel 1: 9-10

Discuss: Who was crying? Hannah

What did she do while she was crying? She prayed to God.

Who heard her praying? God heard her crying.

How often can we pray to God? Anytime we want to. God always hears our prayers and loves it when we talk to Him.

Who can you pray for this week? *EX*: *My mom and all the special women God put into my life*.

Key Point: God Hears our Prayers

God	(Arm straight and finger pointed to heaven)
Hears our Prayers	(Hands folded in prayer)
