Reconrad 70000 and 70010 following direct reported in London Press to Swedish State, Evening Standard by Major General Swed, Diplomatic Correspondent to the Press states Sweden trying to solve rocket puzzle since first one observed late May over town of Sandviken. Observers stated first rocket exploded and produced two smaller rockets which continued on their course. Lt. Col. Jorgen Backlin who spokesman on private business will be consulted by Swedish Govt. Fragments of bombs so far found Sweden bear no markings. No lives lost. Swedish General Staff believe missile fired from Norway now occupied Red Army. Sweden have imposed strict censorship on localities rockets have been observed and where they have crashed. Rockets number 1, talking point in Sweden. Swedish General Staff have requested public to report all observations. Three days after this appeal 300 reports were received. 500 reports are being studied today.

Swedish Prime Minister Herr Hammarskjold said last week that no demands had been made to any Foreign Government concerning rockets because nature and origin still uncertain. Reports received on rockets widely at variance and agree on only one thing that path of flight is along from Southeast when first seen. Descriptions of rockets vary from ball shaped to shuttle and cigar shape. Speed estimated range

Daily Express report by Guy Eden states British radar experts have been sent to Sweden to investigate source of rockets, that experts have reported to Whitehall on what they discovered and will return Sweden with apparatus to work with representatives of Swedish Govt. Sweden has asked loan of radar equipment and has been granted it. Article further states Ruter News Service cables from Berlin documentary evidence Soviet Zone shows Russians are working on V-4 new super rocket from blueprints found in Nazi underground factories. Ten plants in Russian Zone Germany reported producing jet planes, heavy armament, rocket fuel for V weapons and U-boats and torpedo parts. Among plants named are SiemensTelefunken, Krupps and the Leuna oilworks in Saxony which is making new jet plane fuel. Russian and carefully screened German technicians employed. Germans getting high pay and extra rations. Britain also reported to be working on German weapons in British Zone.

AUAM Comment: Squadron Leader Heath and Capt. Malone who are guided missile experts were sent to Sweden by Air Ministry and have returned with negative reports. Intelligence Section Air Ministry reports that a new leak has occurred regarding request of Sweden for radar equipment and also the



Further that although Sweden had requested similar installation and technicians they have now withdrawn request and Air Ministry will send no personnel to Sweden on subject, leaving further negotiations in hands of Foreign Office. Suggest if thought advisable that Keeler be informed of the above.
