

DOOLITTLE IN VENEZUELA

On Tour for Shell Corporation, He Visits With President

CARACAS, Venezuela, April 13—Lieut. Gen. James H. Doolittle, who led the first air raid over Tokyo, left Caracas today after a visit with President Romulo Betancourt for Maracay, where he will review the Venezuelan Air Force. He will go from Maracay to Maracaibo to inspect oil fields there, and will then proceed on Monday to Colombia and Ecuador.

General Doolittle is traveling in the same B-25 bomber from which he bombed Tokyo. His present trip is a combination goodwill tour and visit of inspection for Shell Union Oil Corporation of California, of which he is vice president.
