Missiles reported over Norway all sighted within 25 mile radius of Oslo. One sighted on July 11th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd and two on 18th. One of above headed east, other five going north. Two on 18th reported very low others high in flight. Speed reported as "Lighting fast" and emitting fiery trail but no other description and no parts recovered. Ref covered 446 of 29 July. Another reliable source reports two rockets fired from Russian territory two kilometers east of Lake Ingman on Russian-Finnish border at 2335A 18th July. Missiles appeared to be 15 meters long with exhaust flame of 30 meters. Very steep ascent but seemed to travel southward. Record 451 dated 13th August source has now stated that Denmark broke coded message.
