Reinicke Sworn In by Mayor to Replace Doolittle

Frederick G. Reinicke, Commissioner of Marine and Aviation, was sworn in as a member of the New York City Airport Authority by Mayor O'Dwyer yesterday afternoon in City Hall. Mr. Reinicke took the place of Lieut. Gen. James H. Doolittle, vice president and director of the Shell Union Oil Corporation, who resigned because Shell holds a lease at Idlewild Airport that the city is seeking to renegotiate.

The Mayor also swore in Patrick J. Meehan as Deputy Commissioner of Licenses. Mr. Meehan has been serving as secretary of the department since Jan. 1. He resides at 115-01 107th Avenue, Richmond Hill. He retired from the Police Department in 1941 after twenty years of service.
