Bailey is a 90 lb. Labrador Retriever

Bailey's Anti-Cancer Diet

Bailey's stew was:

1/2 cup of organic dry lentils, boil & simmer in purified water

1 T. Olive Oil

1 lb - Wild-caught Salmon or Tuna or Grass-fed organic beef.

Handful of organic fresh spinach

1 can Organic peas (canned or frozen)

Raw Organic broccoli - 2 stalks

Raw Organic cauliflower - 3/4 cup

Raw Organic green beans - 1 cup

Raw Organic zucchini - 1 small

1 raw organic carrot or 1/2 raw organic sweet potato

1/4 small head of raw organic cabbage chopped

1 organic beet

Once the lentils are soft, add olive oil and season with

1 t. powdered cinnamon,

1 t. garlic,

1 T. turmeric,

A very light shake of red pepper or cayenne,

1 T. Dried parsley.

Add Meat/Salmon/Tuna.

Add the sweet potato or carrot and simmer, adding the other veggies broccoli first — cabbage and spinach last.

You want the veggies chewable but as close to steamed/raw as possible.

Spoon the mixture into a glass storage container and add just about 6 blueberries and sprinkle raw organic ground flaxseed on top. Cover tightly and Store in refrigerator.

Upon each serving, put about 1/4 cup of purified or spring water in feeding bowl, open and pour in powder from Orchard and Garden blend Juice Plus+ capsules (My 90lb. dog gets the adult dose of two of each Red and Green color per day - adjust dose to weight of dog). Dilute the juice powders in the water and add the appropriate feeding portion of the stew, mix and serve to your pup. [I did not give Bailey the Vineyard Blend due to the Concord Grape ingredient, which is harmful to Dogs and Cats]

Bailey was given an anti-inflammatory and antibiotic the vet said had anti-cancer properties that he also took as prescribed. Piroxicam 10 mg 1/day and Baytril 136 mg 2/once a day.

Bailey was diagnosed with inoperable prostate cancer 4/27/16 and diagnosed cancer-free 7/15/16. I continued with the homemade dog food for about 4 more months then introduced 1/2 & 1/2 Canadae "Pure" Wild Salmon dog food, and continue with the adult dose of the Orchard and Garden blend capsules.

He is doing FANTASTIC with all the energy of a 3 yr old dog. He will be 10 years old October of this year.

I do not make any claims or promises this diet will cure your dog, I only believe it helped starve the cancer, empower and strengthen the healthy cells, reduce inflammation and end the cancer cycle in my dog.

Notes:

Once Bailey was declared cancer-free, we took him off the prescriptions per the blessings of his oncologist.

I used Pyrex storage containers as I was afraid of plastic contamination and I made his stew in a stainless-steel cooking pot

I also gave him 1 krill oil capsule per day until I introduced the Canadae Pure Salmon dog food which contains omegas.
