NO MATTER WHAT HAPPENS . . .

1. REMEMBER GOD CAN BRING GOOD "We know that IN ALL that happens God works for the good of those who love him and are called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28 "I will bless the LORD at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth." Psalm 34:1 **Paul's Example:** "I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that everything that has happened to me has helped to spread the Good News." Philippians 1:12 (NLT)

2. NI	EVER LET OTHERS CONTROL

- **CRITICS:** Some indeed preach Christ from envy and rivalry, but others from good will. Vs 15
- **COMPANIONS:** "The latter do it out of love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel." vs. 16."
- **COMPETITORS:** "The former proclaim Christ out of selfish ambition..." vs,
- **CHALLENGERS:** "...not sincerely but thinking to afflict me in my imprisonment." Vs. 17b



Paul's Attitude: "What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed, and in that I rejoice. Yes, and I will rejoice" vs. 18.

"...and not frightened in anything by your opponents. This is a clear sign to them of their destruction, but of your salvation, and that from God." Philippians 1:28

"For it has been granted to you that for the sake of Christ you should not only believe in him but also suffer for his sake, engaged in the same conflict that you saw I had and now hear that I still have. Phil 1:29-30

"I will continue to rejoice, <u>for I know</u> that as you pray for me and as the Spirit of Jesus Christ helps me, <u>all that's happened will all TURN OUT for my deliverance</u>." Philippians 1:19 (NLT)

"It is my <u>eager expectation and hope</u> that I will not be at all ashamed, but that <u>with full courage</u>, now as always, Christ will be honored in my body, whether by life or by death!" Philippians 1:20 (ESV)

"Do not let your <u>happy trust</u> in the Lord die away, <u>no matter what happens.</u> Remember your reward!" Hebrews 10:35 (LB)
