IV. New Business

A. **BAS/Meet your teacher**

BAS is scheduled and will be mailed out today or tomorrow. Teachers will meet families at the main entrance to the building. Grades 1-6 will take students to read while parents wait outside or in the gym/cafeteria if raining. Kindergarten families will be able to go to classrooms.

BAS books can be used. Kids just sanitize or wash their hands before and after reading.

Students will not bring their school supplies to BAS testing.

B. **August Trainings**

Shelly sent out an email on August 19 with some Seesaw resources we can start using. We are still waiting for full access. We are hoping to have this in the next few days.

Staff could create a free account right now to practice if they want.

Staff is encouraged to checkout Seesaw for Teachers on Facebook or YouTube. There will be times scheduled on Google Hangouts to learn more about Seesaw. There will also be times scheduled for Sheri and Chloe to share what they learned at RC training.

Will look at using Covid relief funds, Curriculum budget and/or REAP to compensate for time spent on training. **Staff can start tracking their time on Thursday, August 20 as they research. 40 hours can be submitted for extra time spent between August 20-September 30.**

C. **Hybrid Learning Model- What does it look like**

First three days - Maybe set up appointments with each student. Could be a phone call or google meet. Do small group google meet or zoom meetings. Need some academic components in these three days that can be done virtually. Do not need Seesaw assignments to complete on these three days.

Lots of team time can happen these three days also. Practice sending out group emails.

If you want families to have paper copies of something, you will need to print it and tell families to pick up during office hours.

Teams - talk about what you think these first three days should look like. Shelly will create a shared google doc for teams to write down ideas. We will schedule a K-6 google meet on Wednesday, August 26 at 2:30 for those who can make it.

There will not be hub pickups this fall. Distance learning families can pick up at school. Teachers can send home work with hybrid students to work on during their distance learning days. Lots of work can be done on Seesaw.

The plan is that families who need devices will have them by Friday, September 11.

Lower grades will most likely just have their classroom computers that they have now to start the year. We have about 205 student laptops in the building right now.

D. **What classrooms look like**

Teachers/ staff are in charge of your space. Whatever is in your room you are responsible for cleaning. Cloth items are not recommended. Students get clean materials. Sanitize before and after. Make baggies for individual students with materials you know they will use often. If students need to share materials, they can wear gloves. Students have to stay 6 feet apart though at all times in the hybrid model. Rethinking how to play games needs to happen.
