

Disciple 101 – Meeting 2

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Note: Hand out leader's guide Meeting #2 to everyone and have a different person lead each main point so they all get experience in leading (one leads 'How are you?', another leads 'Vision Casting' and so on).

(1) How Are You? (30 minutes)

1. Have each person share about their family and work.
2. What they are thankful for
3. What they are concerned about (want prayer for).
4. Pray in one accord. (One person prays for a person and then pauses. Anyone else who wants to pray for that same person can also pray. Then when there is a period of silence someone can pray for another person and then pauses ...)

(2) Loving Accountability (10 minutes)

1. Did you meet with Jesus everyday doing the SOS John study?
2. Did you listen to the “Bayside 2014 Easter Service” CD? (if they have not, just ask them if they will listen to it this week. Point out they can listen on their phone by going to www.a-teams.net)
3. Did you send a STAR text every day? Why are we asking for this? To help us daily meet with Jesus AND to encourage our team-mates AND to have something ready for us to share with others.

(3) Vision Casting (10 minutes)

1. What will it cost you to make disciple? Mark 8:34-37 and Matthew 6:33. Note what the rewards will be also.
2. Also remember what Jesus promises in Matthew 4:19b and 28.20b.

(4) Discuss Gospel of John (40 minutes)

1. Have each person share for 5-10 minutes on what they applied (obeyed) this week. This will take time to get used to being specific in application. Might need to discuss again James 1:22, 25 (which focus on obeying).

(5) Fishing (20 minutes)

1. On pages ix and x what 2 things must a person do to be saved?
2. What did you think about the prayer on page x?
3. Together watch and discuss the 4 minute Bridge Illustration on www.a-teams.net. (show them how they can watch it on their smart phones)
4. Handout and go over the “Fishing List”. Have them add at least 10

people to their list.

(5) Messages (5 minutes)

1. Discuss “Bayside 2014 Easter Service” CD

(6) Goals (5 minutes)

1. Pick a day and time that everyone can meet.
2. Fill in the dates in the reading plan until the next meeting.
3. Meet with Jesus every day by studying the daily passage with SOS Bible Study method.
4. Pray for the people on the “Fishing List” everyday asking God to save the non-followers
5. Look at Long-Term Goals

(7) Long-Term Goals (discussed as part of Loving Accountability)

1. Give Life Application Study Bible Gospel of John to at least two people a month. Therefore:
 1. Develop multiple non-Christian friendships.
 2. Learn to share with people you meet in the course of the day
2. Start discussing the Gospel of John with a non-Christian.
3. Start an A-Team with Christian(s).
