

Disciple 101 – Meeting 5

(1) How Are You (30 minutes)

1. Before sharing always open with an opening prayer.
2. Have each person share:
 1. The status of last week's requests
 2. What they are thankful for
 3. What they are concerned about (want prayer for).
3. Pray in one accord for each others requests.

(2) Loving Accountability (10 minutes)

1. What contacts did you have with non-Christians?
2. Who did you ask to study the Gospel of John with?
3. Did we send a STAR text every day?

(3) Our Purpose: Make Multiplying Disciples (5 minutes)

1. John 12:24-26
 1. In v24 what does Jesus want us to do? What will happen if we do die?
 2. How does he define dying in v25? What happens to those who don't die?
 3. In v26 what must we do? What does 'follow me' mean? (know and obey) What will God do for those who follow/serve Jesus?

(4) Follow Jesus (55 minutes)

1. Share your top Dos (the ones you added on the review day). Go in a circle with each one sharing their top Do and discussing it. They repeat the process with the 2nd top Do. And so on with the top 5 Dos
2. Share your top Gods (the ones you added on the review day).
3. Share your top Salvations (the ones you added on the review day).

(5) Fishing and Fishing Tools (15 minutes)

1. Explain the “Personal Testimony Worksheet” and have them complete it before the next meeting because we'll each be sharing ours.
2. What were the main points of the “Bayside 2014 Easter Service” message?
3. Who would this CD be good for?
4. Hand out the “Why I believe in the Bible” CD to listen to it twice.
5. Brainstorm on how we can give out Gospel of Johns? What we can say

(6) Goals (5 minutes)

1. Pick a day and time that everyone can meet.
2. Fill in the dates in the reading plan until the next meeting. Try to have the Review/Do day on the day of next meeting.
3. Meet with Jesus every day by studying the daily passage with STAR Bible Study method.
4. Pray for the people on the “Fishing List” everyday and ask God who to add to the list.
5. Listen to the “Why I believe in the Bible” CD twice.
6. Complete “Personal Testimony” Worksheet.
7. This week, what non-Christian can you make a contact with?
8. This week, who can you ask to do a Gospel of John with?
