## (1a) How Are You (25 minutes)

1. Before sharing always open with an opening prayer.
2. Have each person share:
  1. The status of last week's requests
  2. What they are thankful for
  3. What they are concerned about (want prayer for).
3. Pray in one accord for each others requests.

## (1b) Feedback on the Gospel of John 8 weeks (10 minutes)

1. Please give your honest feedback. You are among the first to do it. We need your honest feedback.
2. What did you like about the A-Team?
3. What would you like to change about the A-Team?
4. How did you like looking for 3 things (Do, God, Salvation)?
5. Would it be better focusing on just Dos?
6. Is texting STARS useful?
7. Please give feedback to Richard Carr

## (2) Loving Accountability (10 minutes)

1. Review long-term goals
2. How many STARS did you send this week?
3. What contacts did you have with non-Christians?
4. Who did you share the messages or Gospel of John with this week?

## (3) Vision Casting: Make Multiplying Disciples (5 minutes)

1. Read Matthew 4:19-20.
  1. What 2 things does Jesus tell us to do?
  2. What does it mean to fish for people?
  3. In this verse who will help us fish for people?
  4. How important is it to Jesus that we fish for people?
  5. Can one 'follow Jesus' and yet ignore his help and direction to fish for people?

## (4) Follow Jesus (30 minutes)

1. Discuss our very top Dos from the whole of the Gospel of John
2. Discuss our very top Gods from the whole of the Gospel of John
3. Discuss our very top Salvations from the whole of the Gospel of John

4. Hand out “The Star Bible Study Method using Matthew” for the next 8 weeks reading schedule.
5. Next week we'll be discussing our STARS.

## (5) Fishing and Fishing Tools (25 minutes)

1. Have everyone practice sharing their “Personal Testimony Worksheet”
2. Refine your testimony and share it with someone this week.
3. What were the main points of the message from last week?
4. Pick the next message from [www.a-teams.net](http://www.a-teams.net).

## (6) Goals (5 minutes)

1. Pick a day and time that everyone can meet.
2. Fill in the dates in the reading plan until the next meeting. Try to have the Review/Do day on the day of the next meeting.
3. Meet with Jesus every day by studying the daily passage with the STAR Bible Study method.
4. Pray for the people on the “Fishing List” everyday and ask God who to add to the list.
5. Listen to the new message twice.
6. Refine your testimony and share it with someone this week.
7. Look at the goals under the “Loving Accountability” section

## (7) Long-Term Goals (discussed as part of Loving Accountability)

1. Develop multiple non-Christian friendships.
2. Share testimony and/or witness to one person a month.
3. Start reading the Gospel of John with a non-Christian.
4. Start an A-Team with a Christian.
