(1) How Are You? (team-mates) (30 minutes)

1. Have each person share:
 1. What they are thankful for
 2. What they are concerned about (want prayer for).
2. Pray in one accord.
3. When to meet next week?

(2) Follow Jesus (45 minutes)

1. Chapter by Chapter have each person share how they are trying to obey (put into practice) for 5-10 minutes (including their Stars).
2. Fill in the reading plan dates for next week
3. Commit to reading prayerfully both the Bible and the notes

(3) Fishing and Disciple-making (25 minutes)

1. Based on Luke 19:10 “For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.” and Luke 9:60 “Your duty is to go and (spread the news HCSB) about the Kingdom of God.” what should we be doing?
2. Have each person share if they had any meaningful contacts with non-Christians and any divine appointments
3. (Pray for the people on the “Fishing List” everyday.)
4. Teach them how to memorize and learn John 14:2b-3.

Long-Term Goals (discussed as part of Loving Accountability)

1. Give Life Application Study Bible Gospel of John (and witness if possible) to at least two people a month. Therefore:
 1. Develop multiple non-Christian friendships.
 2. Learn to share with people you meet in the course of the day ('Divine Appointments')
2. Start discussing the Gospel of John with a non-Christian.
3. Start an A-Team with Christian(s).
