

## What is the ILP?

The ILP is a tool that automatically transfers information from Banner to Canvas.

#### The ILP synchronizes:

- users
- courses
- student enrollments
- faculty assignments
- cross-listing
- academic terms
- grade data

# Purpose for the ILP Newsletter

Since Laredo College adopted Canvas, Banner and Canvas did not communicate with each other, and therefore information was brought into Canvas via a manual upload. Starting in Wintermester 2020, the Ellucian Intelligent Learning Platform (ILP) was implemented to bridge that gap. As a result, there are important changes that affect the way information is handled between Banner and Canvas. We will be sending out the ILP newsletter periodically as we learn about the differences and how the information flows between these two systems. The newsletter will serve to inform the College community of procedural changes that are necessary.

#### **Term Dates**

We can no longer extend or modify course Start and End Dates to make material accessible for students. If courses are manually extended, the content will be visible to students, but it will be impossible for them to make submissions.


Therefore, term dates must be carefully adhered to. If there is a student with incomplete coursework, instructors must follow the Incomplete grading process.

### **Cross-Listing**

Cross-Listing in Banner

When courses are cross-listed in Banner, the course title in Canvas will appear in a format that is different from the usual naming standard.

Instructors can modify the title on the Home page so students can identify the course.



#### Cross-Listing in Canvas

If two or more courses are assigned to an instructor and then cross-listed in Canvas, and one of the courses is reassigned to a different instructor, the ILP does not decross-list the course in Canvas. Both instructors will be placed in the course in Canvas.

# **Canceling Courses**

The ILP automatically deletes canceled courses, so it is important to notify eLearning so that we can make a copy of the course before it is canceled or reassigned. In reassignment cases, the new instructor could overwrite any material in the course, making it impossible for the previous instructor to access any changes they may have made.



It is crucial to contact eLearning before canceling a course or reassigning an instructor.

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
