

What is the ILP?

The ILP is a tool that automatically transfers information from Banner to Canvas.

The ILP synchronizes:

- users
- courses
- student enrollments
- faculty assignments
- cross-listing
- academic terms
- grade data

Purpose of the ILP Newsletter


The Ellucian Intelligent Learning Platform (ILP) was implemented to bridge the gap between Banner and Canvas. **As a result, there are important changes that affect the way information is handled.** We will be sending out the ILP newsletter periodically as we learn about the differences and how the information flows between these two systems. The newsletter serves to inform the College community of necessary procedural changes.

Access to Courses at the End of Term - Extended

As an update to the 4th Issue of the ILP Newsletter, and after extensive research, we identified a setting in the ILP that allows us to extend the term in Canvas until grades are due to the Office of the Registrar. This setting provides faculty access to finalize the gradebook after the final exam period.


Submit Grades to Banner: Current vs. Final Score


To ensure that students receive an accurate grade when using the Submit Grades to Banner tool, the Canvas Gradebook must be complete. **Before using the Submit Grades to Banner tool,** faculty should export the gradebook and compare the **Current Score** and **Final Score** columns to make sure they are the same.




Exporting the Canvas Gradebook

The grade that is pushed by the Submit Grades to Banner tool is the **Current Score** (**Column N** below). The **Current Score** is a total of *graded assignments* and does not factor in assignments that do not have a grade. The **Final Score** (**Column O** below), estimates what the grade would be with zeros included.

Submit Grades to Banner: Current vs. Final Score - Continued When the Current Score and Final Score do not match, the Canvas Gradebook is incomplete. Go back to the Canvas Gradebook and verify that there is a grade on all of the assignments listed there. Then, export the gradebook again, and the Current Score and Final Score should match. At that point, you can use the Submit Grades to Banner tool.
