The Evaluation Committee member ranks the proposals in an order of 1, 2, 3, 4 and so on with #1 being the top ranked and so forth. A summary ranking sheet of all evaluator rankings adds up the ranking totals for each proposal which determines the final committee ranking where the lowest score is the highest ranked firm and so forth.
