## The End Times –

The time of the rapture and beginning of God's wrath are intimately linked events. One follows the other "on the self same day". 1 just as in Noah's day.

The rapture is not signless; the son of perdition is revealed before our gathering to Christ.<sup>2</sup>

Israel makes or accepts an alliance with the antichrist (who breaks the alliance after 3½ years<sup>3</sup>).

The world proclaims peace and safety. 4

Antichrist sets up the abomination of desolation in the temple and proclaims himself as God.<sup>5</sup>

This action identifies (reveals) who Antichrist is and that the world is therefore in the last 7 years of this age.<sup>3</sup> He is the man of sin in II Thess.<sup>6</sup>

The world is warned to not accept his mark; i.e., to identify with the beast.<sup>7</sup>

Those in Judea told to flee immediately.8

Israel told to hide, as it were, for a little while.9

We are told to watch.<sup>10</sup>

Great Tribulation occurs on the earth. Antichrist persecutes Israel and the church. 11

Imminency begins; "He is near, at the very doors." <sup>12</sup>

Tribulation (persecution) ends.<sup>13</sup>

Wrath is about to begin. The sun goes dark.<sup>14</sup>

Hearts fail for fear; men call for the mountains to fall on them and hide them from the wrath of the Lamb. <sup>15</sup> (At this moment remember to <u>watch</u>.)

A bright shining appears in the east <sup>16</sup>

The Glory of the Son of Man appears in the sky and every eye sees Him.('as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber').<sup>17</sup>

The Trumpet sounds. Believers are changed in a moment; the living and resurrected believers are caught up to be with the Lord. 18

Silence is demanded upon the earth and in Heaven. 19

God's wrath falls on the earth and its unbelieving inhabitants.<sup>20</sup>

The Lord and those with Him come to the earth on horses and conquer the beast and antichrist.<sup>21</sup>

Satan is bound and cast into the abyss for 1000 years.<sup>22</sup>

Jesus reigns for 1000 years and we with Him.<sup>23</sup>

Satan is loosed. Some follow him.<sup>24</sup>

The 'dead' are awakened for the final judgment of both men and Satan.<sup>25</sup>
