EndTimesChronology- A broad summary of events, each of which would deserve study and expansion.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Imminence is not a biblical terminology but is the concept that no further signs need to occur pointing toward the return of Jesus to gather His earthly elect and to set His foot again on the Mount of Olives. However, <u>all</u> the signs He gave must first occur prior to the onset of imminence; in particular the revealing of the man of sin (antichrist) and the darkness over all the earth. This imminence is ascribed in scripture by Jesus Himself and differs from definitions postulated by contemporary writers.

The word Rapture similarly is not a biblical term but provides the literary antecedent for the concept and definition that the bible presents.
