- **Drain Lines** Also known as waste piping, these lines carry water from your drains out to the sewer. Much like water lines, these can freeze during the winter. During an inspection, the team will look for clogs, proper angles, and careful insulation where required. Plumbers will also check that water lines and drain lines are properly separated so that wastewater cannot mix with potable water.
- Vent Pipes Vents are important for ensuring proper pressure in the system, so these must be inspected, as well. The plumbers will look for clogs and obstructions that may prevent airflow.

What to Do If a Problem Exists

The purpose of the plumbing inspection is to check for issues, so if an issue is found, it is imperative that it is repaired right away.
