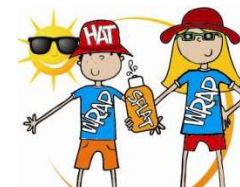

CSP is a 'structured playgroup' where the facilitators set up and provide open-ended play experiences where children can bring their own creativity and explore materials in their own way.

Parents are required to support and guide their own child through the session, as children are at all times the responsibility of the parent/carer. We structure the group so that there is play time, shared snack time, group time and outside time.
