## "REVELATIONS CHAPTER THREE"

(Rev 3:1-22)

(Rev 3:1) And unto the angel of the church in <u>Sardis</u> (*The 5<sup>th</sup> Church Age*) write; These things saith <u>He</u> (*Jesus*) that hath the <u>Seven Spirits Of God</u>, (*One Spirit in 7 Church Ages*) and the <u>Seven Stars</u>; (*Angels Of The 7 Church Ages*) I know thy works, that <u>Thou Hast A Name That Thou Livest</u>, (*Outwardly You Look Alive, But Inwardly You Are Dead*) And <u>Art Dead</u>.

(Matt 23:27) Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which Indeed Appear Beautiful Outward, But Are Within Full Of Dead Men's Bones, and of all uncleanness.)

(Rev 3:2) Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works <a href="Perfect">Perfect</a> (Complete) before God. (Rev 3:3) Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee <a href="As A Thief">As A Thief</a>, (Caught Unaware) and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee. (John 10:10) The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: <a href="I Am Come That They">I Am Come That They</a> <a href="Might Have Life">Might Have Life</a>, and that they might have it more abundantly.)

(Rev 3:4) Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which <a href="Have Not Defiled Their Garments">Have Not Defiled Their Garments</a>; (Have

(Rev 3:4) Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which Have Not Defiled Their Garments; (Have Kept The Faith) And They Shall Walk With Me In White (Righteousness) for they are worthy.

(Rev 3:5) He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels. (Rev 3:6) He that hath an ear, Let Him Hear (Spiritually Discern) what the Spirit saith unto the churches. (Rev 3:7) And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia (The 6th Church Age) write; These things saith He (Jesus) that is holy, he that is true, he that hath The Key Of David, (Knowledge of David's Prophecies Concerning Jesus) He That Openeth, (The Way Back To God) and no man shutteth; and Shutteth, (The Door To Hell) and no man openeth; (Rev 3:8) I know thy works: behold, I Have Set Before Thee An Open Door, (Back To God) and no man can shut it: For Thou Hast A Little Strength, (Weak In The Spirit) and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name. (Rev 3:9) Behold, I will make Them Of The Synagogue Of Satan, (Fallen Angels In People, Tares) which Say They Are Jews, (Those That Keep The Righteousness Of The Law) and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make Them (Fallen Angels) to come and Worship (Prostrate Oneself In Homage) Before Thy Feet, (The Church) and to know that I have loved thee.

(Rev 3:10) Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the Hour Of Temptation, (Time of Discipline, To Examine) (White Throne Judgment) which shall come upon All The World, (Fallen Angels, Tares) To Try (Discipline, Examine) Them that dwell upon the earth. (Rev 3:11) Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that No Man (Fallen Angel) take thy Crown. (Reward) (Rev 3:12) Him that overcometh will I make A Pillar (Source Of Support) In The Temple (The Church) of my God,

(1 Cor 3:16 Know ye not that <u>Ye Are The Temple Of God</u>, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?) (Rev 3:12)(b) And <u>He Shall Go No More Out</u>:(Will Keep The Faith, Will Not Fall Away) And <u>I will Write Upon Him The Name Of My God</u>, (The Word)

(Heb 10:16) This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, <u>I Will</u>

<u>Put My Laws Into Their Hearts, And In Their Minds Will I Write Them</u>;) (Rev 19:13) And he was

clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and <u>His Name Is Called The Word of God</u>.)

(Rev 3:12)(b) And the name of <u>The City Of My God, Which Is New Jerusalem</u>, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name. (*Gal 4:26*) *But <u>Jerusalem</u> Which Is Above Is Free, Which Is The Mother Of Us All.*)

(Rev 3:13) He that hath an ear, <u>Let Him Hear</u> (*Spiritually Discern*) what the Spirit saith unto the churches. (Rev 3:14) And unto the angel of the church of the <u>Laodiceans</u> (*The 7<sup>th</sup> Church Age*) write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God; (Rev 3:15) I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: <u>I Would Thou Wert Cold Or</u> Hot. (*In Order To Know You Needed To Change*)

(Rev 3:16) So then because thou art <u>Lukewarm</u>, (*Don't Know You Need To Change*) And neither cold nor hot, I will <u>Spue Thee Out Of My Mouth</u>. (*Cannot Respond To Or Repeat Your Prayers*) (*Isaiah 59:2*) But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and <u>Your Sins Have</u> Hid His Face From You, That He Will Not Hear.)

(Rev 3:17) Because <u>Thou Sayest, I Am Rich, And Increased With Goods, And Have Need Of Nothing;</u>
(*Desire For Wealth More Than Desire For God*) And knowest not that thou art <u>Wretched, And Miserable, And Poor, And Blind, And Naked</u>.

(Wretched) = "Sick In Mind And Body." (Miserable) = "Don't know who the enemy is"
(Poor) = Don't love each other" (Blind) = "No knowledge of God"
(Naked) = "No Holy Spirit covering in the Soul = mind, will, emotions"

(Rev 3:18) I counsel thee to <u>Buy Of Me Gold Tried In The Fire</u>, (*The Word*) That Thou <u>Mayest Be Rich</u>; (*In Good Works*) And <u>White Raiment</u>, (*Righteousness*) That Thou Mayest <u>Be Clothed</u>, (*Covered By The Holy Spirit*) And that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint <u>Thine Eyes</u> (*spirit*) With <u>Eyesalve</u>, (*The Spirit Of Truth*) That <u>Thou Mayest See</u>. (*Spiritually Discern*) (Rev 3:19) As many as I love, I <u>Rebuke And Chasten</u> (*Reprove*, *Convict*, *Instruction*, *Teach*) (2 Tim 3:16) All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, <u>For Reproof</u>, <u>For Correction</u>, For Instruction in righteousness:)

(Heb 12:9 Furthermore we have had <u>Fathers Of Our Flesh</u> which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto <u>The Father Of Spirits</u>, and live?) (God is <u>The Father Of Our Spirit Not Of Our Flesh</u> Therefore he deals with our spirit not our flesh, teaching and correcting us by his Word, which is spiritually discerned.

(Rev 3:20) Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. (Ro 8:16) <u>The Spirit Itself Beareth</u> <u>Witness With Our Spirit</u>, that we are the children of God:)

(Rev 3:21) To him that overcometh will I <u>Grant To Sit With Me In My Throne</u>, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

(Eph 2:6) And hath raised us up together, and <u>Made Us Sit Together In Heavenly Places In Christ lesus</u>:)

(Rev 3:22) He that hath an ear, <u>Let Him Hear</u> (*Spiritually Discern*) what the Spirit saith unto the churches.
