## "REVELATIONS CHAPTER FIVE"

(Rev 5:1-14)

(Rev 5:1) And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, <u>Sealed With Seven Seals</u>.

"Sealing a scroll was a common and important practice in Biblical times. The wills of both Emperor Vespasian and Caesar Augustus were secured with seven seals." For such a document, a scribe would procure a long roll of parchment and begin writing. After a period of writing he would stop, roll the parchment enough to cover his words and seal the scroll at that point with wax. Then he would resume writing, stop again, roll the scroll, and add another seal. By the time he was finished, he would have sealed the scroll seven times. The scrolls would be read a section at a time, after each seal was opened.

"OPENING THE 7 SEALS WOULD RELEASE KNOWLEDGE OF WHAT WAS WRITTEN IN THE BOOK, NOT CAUSE EVENTS TO HAPPEN. THE KNOWLEDGE RELEASED HAD BEEN SEALED BY A MAN CALLED DANIEL, THEREFORE IT MUST BE OPENED BY A MAN, THE SON OF MAN, JESUS, THE LAST ADAM."

(Dan 12:4) But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and <u>Seal The Book</u>, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

(Rev 5:2) And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to <u>Loose The Seals Thereof</u>? (*Release Knowledge*)

(Rev 5:3) And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

(Rev 5:4) And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

(Rev 5:5) And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, <u>The Lion Of The Tribe Of Juda</u>, <u>The Root Of David</u>, <u>Hath Prevailed To Open The Book</u>, <u>And To Loose The Seven Seals Thereof</u>.

(Jesus Released The Knowledge Of <u>Past</u>, <u>Present</u> And <u>Future</u> Events) (Rev 22:16) I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. <u>I am the root and the offspring of David</u>, and the bright and morning star.

(Rev 5:6) And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the Four Beasts, (Seraphim's) and in the midst of The Elders, (Those Jesus brought out of Hell/Abrahams Bosom) Stood A Lamb (Jesus) As It Had Been Slain, (At Calvary) Having Seven Horns (Complete Power) And Seven Eyes, (Fullness Of The Spirit) which are the Seven Spirits Of God Sent Forth Into All The Earth. (One Spirit In The Seven Church Ages)

(Eph 4:4) There is one body, and <u>One Spirit</u>, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;)
(Eph 2:18 For through him we both have access by <u>One Spirit</u> unto the Father.)

(Rev 5:7) And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

(Rev 5:8) And when he had taken the book, the <u>Four Beasts</u>, (<u>Seraphim's</u>) and <u>Four And Twenty</u> <u>Elders</u> (<u>Those Jesus Brought Out Of Hell/ Abrahams Bosom</u>) fell down before <u>The Lamb</u>, (<u>Jesus</u>) Having every one of them <u>Harps</u>, (<u>Praise</u>) <u>And</u>=(<u>Even As</u>) <u>Golden Vials</u> (<u>The Church, Candlestick's Golden bowls</u>) Full Of <u>Odours</u>, (<u>Prayers, Incense</u>) which are <u>The Prayers</u> (<u>Odours, Incense</u>) Of Saints. (<u>Golden Vials</u>)

(2 Tim 2:20-21) But in a great house there are not only <u>Vessels Of Gold</u> and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour. 21 <u>If A Man Therefore Purge Himself</u> from these, <u>He Shall Be A Vessel</u> (Golden Bowl, Golden Vial, Golden Candlestick) <u>Unto Honour</u>, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.)

(Rev 16:1) And I heard a great voice out of <u>The Temple</u> (The Church) saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out <u>The Vials Of The Wrath Of God Upon The Earth.</u>) = (The Prayers Of The Saint's)

(Prov 18:21) <u>Death And Life Are In The Power Of The Tongue</u>: (Matt 12:37) For <u>By Thy Words</u> thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.)

(Rev 5:9) And <u>They</u> (*Those Jesus Brought Out Of Hell/Abrahams Bosom*) Sung A <u>New Song</u>, (*The Song of Moses, (Rev 15:3*) Saying, Thou Art Worthy to take the book, and to <u>Open The Seals</u> (*Released The Knowledge*) Thereof: For Thou <u>Wast Slain</u>, (*At Calvary*) And <u>Hast Redeemed Us To God By Thy Blood Out Of Every Kindred, And Tongue, And People, And Nation; (*Those Jesus Brought Out Of Hell/Abrahams Bosom*)</u>

(Rev 5:10) And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: And <u>We Shall Reign On The Earth</u>.

(During The 1000 yr Millennium)

(Rev 5:11) And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and <u>The Beasts</u> (*Seraphim's*) And <u>The Elders</u>: (*Those Jesus Brought Out Of Hell/Abrahams Bosom*) And the number of them was <u>Ten Thousand Times Ten Thousand</u>, <u>And Thousands Of Thousands</u>;

(Rev 7:9-14) After this I beheld, and, lo, A Great Multitude, Which No Man Could Number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; 10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. 11 And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God, 12 Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. 13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they? 14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These Are They Which Came Out Of Great Tribulation, (Hell/Abrahams Bosom) and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

(Rev 5:12) Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is <u>The Lamb</u> (*Jesus, The Son Of Man*) that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. (Rev 5:13) And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever. (Rev 5:14) And the <u>Four Beasts</u> (*Seraphim's*) Said, Amen. And the <u>Four And Twenty Elders</u> (*Those Jesus Brought Out Of Hell/Abrahams Bosom*) fell down and <u>Worshipped Him</u> (*Jesus*) That Liveth Forever And Ever.
