"REVELATIONS CHAPTER TWENTY-ONE" Keith Porter 3/29/2014

(Rev 21:1-27)

(Rev 21:1) And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was No More Sea. (No More Tares In The Wheat, Isa 57:20)
(Rev 21:2) And I John Saw The Holy City, New Jerusalem, Coming down from God out of heaven, Prepared As A Bride Adorned For Her Husband. (A Natural Illustration Of A Spiritual Concept)
(Rev 21:3) And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, The Tabernacle Of God Is With Men, And He Will Dwell With Them, And they shall be his people, And God Himself Shall Be With Them, And Be Their God.

(1 Cor 15:28) And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that <u>God May Be All In All</u>.

(Rev 21:4) And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more <u>Death</u>, (*Satan*) <u>Neither Sorrow</u>, <u>Nor Crying</u>, neither shall there be <u>Any More Pain</u>: (*From The Influence Of Fallen Angels*) For The Former Things Are Passed Away.

(Rev 21:5) And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: For these words are true and faithful.

(Rev 21:6) And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of The Fountain Of The Water Of Life Freely. (The Holy Spirit)

(John 4:14) But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him A Well Of Water Springing Up Into Everlasting Life.

(John 7:38-39) He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow Rivers Of Living Water. 39 (But This Spake He Of The Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

(Rev 21:7) He that overcometh shall inherit all things; And <u>I Will Be His God, And He Shall Be My Son</u>. (1 John 3:2) Beloved, <u>Now Are We The Sons Of God</u>, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

(Rev 21:8) But The <u>Fearful</u>, <u>And Unbelieving</u>, <u>And The Abominable</u>, <u>And Murderers</u>, <u>And Whore Mongers</u>, <u>And Sorcerers</u>, <u>And Idolaters</u>, <u>And All Liars</u>, (<u>Satan's & Fallen Angels</u>) shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: <u>Which Is The Second Death</u>.

(Rev 21:9) And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, <u>I Will Shew Thee The Bride, The Lamb's Wife</u>. (*The Church*)

(Rev 21:10) And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me That Great City, The Holy Jerusalem, (As A Bride Adorned For Her Husband.) (A Natural Illustration Of A Spiritual Concept) Descending Out Of Heaven From God,

(Rev 21:11) Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

(Rev 21:12) And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: (Rev 21:13) On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates.

(Rev 21:14) And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

(Rev 21:15) And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof.

(Rev 21:16) And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.

(Rev 21:17) And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.

(Rev 21:18) And the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and the city was pure gold, like unto clear glass.

(Rev 21:19) And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald;

(Rev 21:20) The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.

(Rev 21:21) And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.

(Rev 21:22) And <u>I Saw No Temple Therein</u>: For The <u>Lord God Almighty And The Lamb Are The Temple Of It</u>.

(John 14:20) At that day ye shall know that <u>I Am In My Father</u>, <u>And Ye In Me</u>, <u>And I In You</u>.

(1 Cor 15:28) And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that <u>God May Be All In All</u>.

(1 Cor 3:16) Know ye not that Ye Are The Temple Of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

(Rev 21:23) And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, And The Lamb is the light thereof.

(Rev 21:24) And the nations of them which are saved shall <u>walk in the light</u> (*Knowledge*) of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.

(Rev 21:25) And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night (*Lack Of Knowledge*) there.

(Rev 21:26) And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it.

(Rev 21:27) And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.
