Why Implement 5S?



Creates proper environment for standard work

Prerequisite to perfect quality

Encourages visual control

Helps identify waste

Places high value on safety

Promotes employee satisfaction

Step 1: Seiri – Segregate & Discard

Step 2: Seiton – Arrange & Identify

Step 3: Seiso – Clean & Inspect Daily

Step 4: Seiketsu – Revisit Frequently

Step 5: Shitsuke – Motivate To Sustain

The Essence of Progressive 5S



**It's all about Organization and Discipline ... not housekeeping!
There are different expectations & levels of organization
for each level.**

<i>Level</i>	<i>Key Activity</i>	<i>Key Learning or Discipline</i>
1. Sort	5S Red Tag	Remove unnecessary items
2. Set	Assign & Label	Designate "a home for everything"
3. Sustain	Return	"Put it back" after use
4. Simplify	Productivity	Eliminate the non-value added effort
5. Standardize	Plant-wide	Expand ownership & Leverage the gains
