

How the U.S. Government Is Organized

(Separation of Powers)

- 1) <u>Legislative Branch</u> Makes the laws (<u>Congress</u>, comprised of the **a**) House of Representatives and **b**) Senate located in the Capitol Bldg)
- 2) <u>Executive Branch</u> Carries out the laws (President, Vice President, Cabinet, most federal agencies located in the White House)
- 3) <u>Judicial Branch</u> Evaluates laws / makes judgements (Supreme Court and the other Federal courts)
