



How the U.S. Government Is Organized

(Separation of Powers)

- 1) Legislative Branch** - Makes the laws (Congress, comprised of the **a)** House of Representatives and **b)** Senate - located in the Capitol Bldg)
 - 2) Executive Branch** - Carries out the laws (President, Vice President, Cabinet, most federal agencies - located in the White House)
 - 3) Judicial Branch** - Evaluates laws / makes judgements (Supreme Court and the other Federal courts)
