Proper dance attire enables the teacher to see the dancers' positions and movement in order to give necessary corrections for the benefit of the dancer's education. A dress code also teaches discipline and professionalism, which we feel is an important part of dance and life.

Baby/PreK (3&4), Kinderoo (4&5), Combo A (5-7) & Combo B (6-8)

Tutu's or dresses of your choice. Pink Ballet Shoes & Black Tap Shoes.

Advanced Combo

Pink or Black Leotard Dress or Leotard with Skirt, Pink Ballet Tights with Pink Ballet Shoes & Black Tap Shoes.

HipHop & Mini Groovers

Any active/dance wear of your choice. Must be comfortable and flexible. No denim or street clothes. Black/White hightop/lowtop sneakers are required for HipHop. These sneakers must be worn for studio use only. Advanced HipHop Class are required to wear white hightop converse type sneakers. (Black Tap Shoes needed for Mini Groovers also).

Ballet 1 & 2, Intermediate Ballet & Advanced Ballet

Black leotard, "Ballet Pink" tights, Pink split sole canvas ballet shoes.

Jazz 1 & 2, Intermediate Jazz & Advanced Jazz - Beg/Int Tap

Any leotard of your choice (any style/color). Black leggings or shorts. Tan Jazz Shoes. Black Tap Shoes (slip on/lace up).

Contemporary & Technique

Black leotard, black shorts or black tights. Contemporary Socks. Foot Undies or Turning Shoes.

<u>Acro</u>

Leotard of your choice and biker shorts leggings and/or footless tights. Bare feet.

Please ensure that hair is in a pony tail/braid and off the face and neck for ALL classes. Ballet and Acro students MUST wear their hair in a bun. No headbands, jewelry, denim or 2 pieces to be worn in any class.
