₲ Chat GPT

is an 'Al-powered **CHATBOT**' (chatbot was originally called 'chatterbot' - [https://www.Chatbot.com/] - which is basically, a

computer program, that simulates all human conversation, with an end user. One of the 'best' <u>chatbots</u> at present is ... [https://www.ProProfsChat.com/].

ChatGPT (a "version" of <u>chatbot</u>) was created by **OpenAI** ... and it can see, hear, and speak. **ChatGPT** could be used for "many" things ... information, summarizing ideas, meal planning, emotional support, work help, relationships ... etc, etc, etc.

<u>Have an eBiz</u>? - ChatGPT could: generate leads - book appointments - make sales - service your clients ... 24 hours a day ... 7 days a week ... all FOR you.

We could also say that **ChatGPT** is like a super-smart "librarian", who has read every single book in the library. **ChatGPT** can answer questions, generate creative content, and help with writing and learning, across many topics.

ChatGPT uses 'advanced machine-learning' to understand, and respond, just like a real person. BUT ... just like a real librarian ... **ChatGPT** really does need "context" - in order to give the right answer. For example, the word BAT could mean - a 'baseball bat' - or say, a 'flying mammal'.

So, when using **ChatGPT** on your Desktop, be sure to "give it clear details" for the best responses. Know for sure what you want, and be able to "explain" it concisely - with the applicable context, directions, instructions, etc ...

<u>COST</u> of <u>ChatGPT</u>? - NO cost to sign up for an account, but we could go for <u>ChatGPT</u> <u>Plus</u> for \$20 a month, and get a few more features. However, if we rarely use <u>ChatGPT</u>, or just want to see how it works, we can use it 'without' signing up for an account.

How to USE ChatGPT? 1) Go to (https://chat.OpenAl.com) from a browser, and Login, or sign up for it. The 'basic' version of ChatGPT is Free ... 2) Put your "prompt" into the message box on the ChatGPT page. 3) Wait for ChatGPT to come up with a response.
