Yes/No	Clothes: T-shirts, trousers, polo shirts, jumpers, shorts, jackets, - layers are best. (Golfing and casual attire). Sports clothes for after golf games and fitness sessions.

Yes/No	Golf Hat/Cap (We will be giving all juniors a cap in their goodie bag and expect this to be worn so we know our juniors on the course)
