

New ETA Requirement for GREAT BRITAIN & NORTHERN IRELAND

New Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) Requirement

Starting **2025**, all visitors to the UK who do not require a visa, except for British and Irish citizens, will need to obtain an **Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA)**. This digital permission is required for everyone, including children, who wish to enter or transit through the UK.

Key Details:

Who Needs an ETA?

- Visitors to the UK for tourism, family visits, business, or study for up to 6 months.
- Those transiting through a UK airport.
- Eligible non-Europeans can apply starting **November 27, 2024**, for travel from **January 8, 2025**.
- Eligible Europeans can apply from March 5, 2025, for travel from April 2, 2025.

Who Does Not Need an ETA?

- Holders of British and Irish passports.
- Individuals with permission to live, work, or study in the UK.
- Visa holders.

How to Apply:

You can apply for your ETA via the **UK ETA app** or online at https://www.gov.uk/eta Each traveller, including children, must have their own ETA, and approval typically takes up to **3** working days.

Cost and Validity:

- The ETA will cost £16 per person.
- It will be valid for multiple journeys over **two years** or until your passport expires, whichever comes first.
