## Winter Trail Network of Richard St. Barbe Baker Afforestation Area Urban Regional Park

The afforestation area is 326 acres in size. It was planted as part of the Green Survival Program in 1972 and preserved in perpetuity as an urban regional park. The Winter Trail network was created by the Fatlanders FatTire Brigade. Paul Hanley (biographer) refers to Richard St. Barbe Baker, the founder of the International Tree Foundation, as the first global conservationist.

### Respect the Rules

- Follow the trails
- Respect at-risk species
- Remove anything you bring in
- Leave no trace
- No motorized vehicles
- No open fires or camping
- Protect the trees and forest
- No cutting trees
- Do not bring in wood (it may have Dutch Elm Disease)

### Parking P2 Directions

1. South on Circle Drive towards the landfill
2. Take Valley Road
3. Drive past the land fill and Civic Operations Centre-Snow Dump
4. Turn right on Cedar Villa Road / Township Road 362A
5. Take a quick left turn and continue north for 1.2 km
6. Turn north into the parking lot for the 14.5 acre SW Off Leash Recreation Area (SW OLRA)
