Our media institutions have been morally bankrupt for a while, which is why they are so easily attacked now, with no mass rallies staged in their defense. There are exceptions to the rule, of course, but the fact that they are described as exceptions defines the problem.

Still, there is a sense all around us that millions of people are looking for a way to fight back, to put the nation and the world back on a track toward a more civil society guided by social justice.

Well, all journeys toward victory start with the first step.

A nation's media institutions are not the same as its people, but they are ultimately shaped by the people. Social movements can force governments to act in the interest of the people if organized around clear goals, guided by smart strategy and practiced in applying creative tactics. Likewise, authentic journalism can operate outside the constraints of profit-driven media companies to tell the truths that would otherwise be censored by the profit motive. We, the people, do have the power to win here.

The Salon of Authentic Journalism is about accomplishing just that. This April, with your help, we plan to bring together dozens of social-movement leaders, organizers and authentic journalists from around the globe to collaborate, examine victories and defeats, to learn from each other — with the goal of taking those lessons back home and teaching a younger generation the art and science of organizing and committing journalism in the service of the people. It's an uplifting experience for all, but more importantly, the Salon can one day train hundreds of authentic journalists and community organizers, many who are already in the field working relentlessly in the service of human rights.

The Salon will teach theory, but it also is heavily focused on practice. From there, Salon participants can take those tools back into the world, into their communities, and day by day help to build effective social movements that press back against corrupt power and ultimately empower the oppressed and the democracy.

But first, we have to gather together a group of experienced media, social movement leaders and organizers across a range of struggles and with a range of experiences and talents. The first Salon, then, will include a list of already proven superstars in their respective talents and local struggles for freedom and justice.
