

The Wonder of Woman

As I listened to my partner as she verbalized the pleasures of our intimacy,
As I felt her body reacting and responding to it,
As a man, I felt deeply the absence of not knowing first hand what she was experiencing.
While I was instrumental in what she was experiencing, I was a bystander.

*A woman's body is designed to create ova, to ovulate, to conceive or menstruate and repeat.
A man's body is designed to create sperm and ejaculate it through a woman's vagina to her ovum..
A woman is predisposed to copulating when ovulating in which a man enters her body through her vagina to
deliver his sperm to her ovum. Sperm and ova are cells containing genetic information.
