1920s-1930s: Mica chimney, Coleman® U&lc*, black, underline. Found on L227, L327, L427, L220/228, 220/228, 220/228B.

1920s-1930s: Mica chimney, GENUINE Coleman® U&lc*, underline, embossed on upper frame. Found on L227, L327, L427, L220/228, 220/228, 220/228B.

1931-1933*: Etched stenciled Coleman® U&lc*, 3 dash underline, stenciled T.M. REG., PYREX, U.S. PAT. OFF., in 4 dash circle on the upper back, with stenciled MADE IN USA curved below the circle. Found on 220/228B.





1931-1933*: Etched sunshine logo over stenciled Coleman®, U&lc*, 3 dash underline, stenciled T.M. REG., PYREX, U.S. PAT. OFF., in 4 dash circle on upper back. Also seen with MADE IN USA under the sunshine logo. Found on 220/228B.

1931-1933*: This PYREX logo is seen on some of the above globes, as well as PYREX alone on the upper back. Found on 220/228B.

1931-1933*: Etched sunshine logo over stenciled Coleman®, U&lc*, 3 dash underline, stenciled T.M. REG., PYREX, U.S. PAT. OFF., in 4 dash circle on upper front. Found on 220/228B, 242.

1931-1933*: Etched sunshine logo over stenciled Coleman®, U&lc*, 3 dash underline, with MADE IN USA under, stenciled T.M. REG., PYREX, U.S. PAT. OFF., in 4 dash circle on upper back. Found on 220/228B.

***Note:** 1931-1933 etched Coleman® logos came in several variations (4 to 6 known), with or without the sunshine logo, PYREX logo upper front or back and the timeline of each is not known.



1933-1946: Large Green straight line Coleman®, U&lc*, PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. on lower back.
Found on 220/228B, 220/228C, 220/228D.

1946-1947: Large Green straight line "COLEMAN®" Upper Case, PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. on back.
End of 1946 to mid 1947. Found on 220/228D, 242C.

Mid 1940s: Green sunshine logo over Coleman®, U&lc*, different font, lowered 'C', underlined, larger than later sunshine logo. Transitional to the 1946-1958 logo. Found on a 228C



1947: Green sunshine logo over Coleman®, U&lc*, more condensed 'o' and different 'a' than later sunshine logo. no underline. PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. on lower back. Found on an A 1947 220D

1946-1958: Small Green sunshine logo over Coleman®, U&lc*, underlined, PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. on lower back. Most common. Found on 220/228C, 220/228D, 220/228E.

Note: Some overlapping of years took place and there were some transitional designs.



1946-1958: Small Green sunshine logo over Coleman®, U&lc*; underlined, PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. on lower back. Most common. Possibly the earliest amber globe (mid 1950s). This would overlap with the 1946-1947 COLEMAN® all CAPS in those years. Found on 220/228C, 220/228D, 220/228E.

Mid 1940s-1952: U.S. over PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. Found on 252 Early Military Spec Lanterns (single mantle, but 220 globe size).

Late 1940s-1952: U.S. over PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. Wide 'Y'. Found on 252 Early Military Spec Lanterns (single mantle, but 220 globe size).

Mid 1940s: No markings, old glass with waves and small bubbles. Replacement globe for 220, 228. Found on 220/228C, 237B, 252 Early Military Spec Lanterns.

After 1952: Stenciled U S over QUADRANT GLOBE GASOLINE LANTERN STOCK NUMBER 6260-174-3874. 4 piece attached with steel clips. Found on 1950s Military Spec Lanterns.

1958-1962: Curved PYREX over ® MADE IN U.S.A. FOR over red Coleman®, parallelogram logo, has ®, no lantern image. Found on 220/228E.

Mid 1960s: Sears made by Coleman®, no Coleman® logo, curved red PYREX over ®, over MADE IN U.S.A. Found on Sears Model 476, 220/228 Style.

1962-1977: Curved PYREX over ® MADE IN U.S.A. FOR over red or white Coleman®, parallelogram logo, has ®, with lantern image. Amber were available. Found on 220/228E, 220/228F, 220/228G, 220/228H, 220/228J.





1977-1979: Curved PYREX over ® MADE IN U.S.A. FOR over red or white Coleman®, parallelogram logo, has ® & lantern, USED ON 220, 228 below. Amber were available. Found on 220/228J, 220K.

1979-1983: MADE IN USA FOR over red or white Coleman®, parallelogram logo, has the ® & lantern, USED ON 220, 228 below, no PYREX logo. Amber were available. Found on 220/228J, 220K.

1980-1983: Straight PYREX over Made in U.S.A. for over red or white Coleman®, parallelogram logo, has ® & lantern, USED ON 220, 290 below. Found on 220J/220K, white on “Picket Fence” frosted globes.

1983-2015: White Made in U.S.A. for over stenciled Coleman®, dashed parallelogram logo, has ® & lantern. Replacement globe for 220, 228, 235, 290, 2600 models.

1990s: Red Coleman®, parallelogram logo, has ® & lantern. Replacement globe for 220, 228, 235, 290.

1983-2020: MADE IN U.S.A. FOR over red or white Coleman®, parallelogram logo, or GLOBE MADE IN (country of manufacture) FOR. Replacement globes for 220, 228, 235, 290, 2600 models.

Double Mantle Lanterns of United States Manufacture

	1920s-1930s:	Mica chimney, Coleman®, U&lc*, black, underline. Found on L227, L327, L427, L220/228, 220/228, 220/228B.
	1920s-1930s:	Mica chimney, GENUINE Coleman®, U&lc*, underline, embossed on upper frame. Found on L227, L327, L427, L220/228, 220/228, 220/228B.
	1931-1933:	Etched Sunshine logo over stenciled Coleman®, U&lc*; 3 dash underline, stenciled T.M. REG., PYREX, U.S. PAT. OFF., in 4 dash circle on upper back (most common). Found on 220/228B. Note: 1931-1933 etched Coleman® logos came in several variations (4 to 6 known), with or without the sunshine logo, or MADE IN U.S.A. PYREX logo upper back and the timeline of each is not known.
	1933-1946:	Large green straight line Coleman®, U&lc*; PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. on lower back. Found on 220/228B, 220/228C, 220/228D.
	1946-1947:	Large green straight line COLEMAN®, Upper Case. PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. on lower back. End of 1946 to mid 1947. Found on 220D/228D, 242C.
	Mid 1940s-1952:	U.S. over PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. Also came with a wide 'Y' on PYREX. Found on 252 Early Military Spec Lanterns (single mantle, but 220 globe size).
	Mid 1940s:	No markings, old glass with waves and small bubbles. Replacement globe for 220, 228. Found on 220/228C, 237B, 252 Early Military Spec Lanterns.
	Mid 1940s:	Green sunshine logo over Coleman®, U&lc*, different font, lowered 'C', underlined, larger than the later sunshine logo. This appears to be a transition to the 1946-1958 sunshine logo. Found on a 228C.
	1947	Green sunshine logo over Coleman®, U&lc*, more condensed 'o' and different 'a' than later sunshine logo, no underline. PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. on lower back. Found on an A-1947 220D
	1946-1958:	Small green sunshine over Coleman®, U&lc, underlined, PYREX MADE IN U.S.A. on lower back. Most common. Available in possibly the earliest amber globe (mid 1950s). Found on 220/228C, 220/228D, 220/228E.
	After 1952:	Stenciled U S over QUADRANT GLOBE GASOLINE LANTERN STOCK NUMBER 6260-174-3874. 4 piece attached with steel clips. Found on 1950s Military Spec Lanterns. (single mantle, but 220 globe size).
	1958-1962:	Curved PYREX over ®, over MADE IN U.S.A. FOR over red Coleman®, parallelogram logo. Has the ®, no lantern image. Found on 220/228E.
	Mid 1960s:	Sears made by Coleman®, no Coleman® logo, curved red PYREX over ®, over MADE IN U.S.A. Found on Sears Model 476, 220/228 Style.
	1962-1977:	Curved PYREX over ®, over MADE IN U.S.A. FOR over red or white Coleman®, parallelogram logo. Has ® with lantern. Amber version was available. Found on 220/228E, 220/228F, 220/228G, 220/228H, 220/228J.
	1977-1979:	Curved PYREX over ®, over MADE IN U.S.A. FOR red Coleman®, parallelogram logo. Has ® with lantern, USED ON 220, 228 below. Amber version was available. Found on 220/228J, 220K.
	1979-1983:	MADE IN USA FOR over red or white Coleman®, parallelogram logo. Has ® with lantern, USED ON 220, 228 below, no PYREX. Amber version was available. Found on 220/228J, 220K.
	1980-1983:	Straight PYREX over Made in U.S.A. for over red or white Coleman®, parallelogram logo, has ® & lantern, USED ON 220, 290 below, white on 'Picket Fence' frosted globes. Found on 220K.
	1983-2020:	MADE IN U.S.A. FOR over red or white Coleman®, parallelogram logo, or GLOBE MADE IN (country of manufacture) FOR. Replacement globes for 220/228.
	1983-2015:	White Made in U.S.A. for over stenciled Coleman®, dashed parallelogram logo, has ® & lantern. Replacement globe for 220, 228, 235, 290, 2600 models.
