After reviewing your application for the 2013 Part II oral examination, it has come to the attention to the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery that you do not have admitting and operating privileges at a hospital as required to sit for the Part II exam. It appears that you are currently only credentialed at surgery centers. Section IV.D. of the Board's Rules and Procedures state that "...
