

Summary Minutes of Canton Liberal Club Committee Meeting 9th December 2021

The Chairman opened the meeting and the Secretary read the minutes of the previous meeting which were accepted. The Acting Treasurer then read out the 'Treasurer's Report and the 'Accounts for Payment' It was noted that the final instalment of the bill for Electrical Safety work would be made shortly.

Correspondence

Three items were read out:

- 1) a Xmas card from St. John's church with a note thanking us for allowing them to use our railings for their banner;
- 2) a letter from a member concerning the heating in parts of the club. The various problems with heating are awaiting a visit from the company that services the heating units.
- 3) a complaint from a member about customer service.

The Chairman allocated duties.

Any other business:

The Chairman updated the Committee on the progress made in helping the Snooker team in line with their recent letter to the Club. The raffle proceeds have paid for their registration and next few sums raised will go to purchase equipment to replace that stolen. The cleaning of the tables was organised, and the Committee agreed to the Snooker team designating a match table which they would look after. They also requested permission to hold a Super tournament of the 19th of December. This was agreed unanimously.

The Committee then discussed the excellent work done by David Hewett as Secretary and his continuing support by advising the Club on business matters.

The Committee then discussed the arrangements for New Year's Eve. It was agreed visitors can use the Club but that the Hall will be ticket holders only with members getting priority. Non-members will need to write in and may have any spare tickets on a first come first served basis. It was agreed to open the Club at 12:00 hrs. on New Year's Eve and that the Hall would remain closed until opened at 18:00 hrs for ticket holders. The Hall would be limited to 150 people. This was agreed by a majority.

The need for a cigarette butt outside was discussed. The Secretary will look to provide a suitable receptacle.

It was noted that the Special meeting to re-appoint scrutineers would take place in the Alexandra Lounge at 8 pm and the Election for Chairman would take place between 19:00 and 22:00 hrs on Friday 10th, Saturday 11^t, and Sunday the 12th of December with voting taking place in the bar.
