

Fords of the Arnon River in Jordan

(When to flee there)

Note: Jordan calls this the Wadi Mujib Tourist Location. Do not call it by this name if you can help it. Mujib is a false god reference.

When to Flee there if you are in the Dead Sea area and the southern Jordan River Valley especially in Judea:

This will become a protected area for people who do not have the Mark of the Beast on their right hand or forehead beginning at the 7th Trumpet. It will remain safe until the Battle of the Great Day has come to an end.

I used to believe that this was the safe location mentioned in Rev 12 but that is not the case. This (F of the AR) is found in Isaiah 16 and Jeremiah 48. These two chapters are all about the Battle of the Great Day of God Almighty mentioned in Rev 16 (6th Bowl) passage. Jesus RETURNS in Power to start this Battle at the pouring of the 7th Bowl. The moment Jesus Appears all people who belong to Jesus will be gathered to Him above Zion. Many people in the Fords of the Arnon River will vanish. The remaining people will be sheltered and protected by Almighty God there while Jesus and His weapons of Indignation PASS OVER and PASS THROUGH the land.

At some point during the Battle Jesus will repay *Jordan* for their sins against His people.

Angels will ensure that the storms and the "My mighty ones" Crusaders will Pass Over and Pass Through without touching those in this River Valley. You can view many tourist videos of this location on youtube. You will have to search for it using the name that Jordan calls it. {The wadi mujib}. Just remember that Christians should call it the Fords of the Arnon River.

Here is how we will know when the 7th angel has blown the 7th Trumpet: First we must realize that the 7th Trumpet is not the Last Trumpet. **The Last Trumpet is Zechariah 9:14 & Isaiah 13:4** and is blown by Lord God Jesus Himself to muster His armies for Battle. That is the gathering of the Bride Army "My sanctified ones" and the Crusader "My mighty ones". The 7th Trumpet will be very obvious for those who are in Jerusalem. They will see the two witnesses Elijah and Moses rising slowly from the dead up into heaven in Jerusalem. At that moment an earthquake will occur there and 7,000 people will die. **This will occur 1,290 days following an event in Jerusalem called the "Abomination of Desolation". (Daniel 11:29-35, 2 Thesalonians 2:4, Rev 13:5).** Less than 45 days following the 7th Trumpet, the Overflowing Scourge will begin to Pass through the land from the Brook of Egypt to the Euphrates River. Jesus will cast out of the Land all who offend Him and who have come against His people, His Land, His holy city and His Inheritance.

Another words Bridesmaids whose lamps are not lit will need to hide during the many days of the Battle of the Great Day of God Almighty. All chapters in the Book of Isaiah from mid Isaiah 10 thru Isaiah 66 are all about this Battle.
