SUMMARY OF JUNE FINANCIAL REPORTS

The Revenue and Expenditure Report and the Cash Summary Report are included in the agenda packet for July 23, 2018. Following is a summary of each report.

Revenue and Expenditure Report

June is the last month of our fiscal year, therefore, actual revenues and expenses should be near 100% of the budget. The revenues and expenditures of most funds are in-line with this benchmark. Major Funds with large variations from the 100% benchmark (and applicable reasoning) are as follows:

- General Fund: Expenditures at 84% Blight Grant activity at 76%. Demolition is complete on all houses that are a part of the grant project; final payments to contractors will be posted back to June once paid. Final payments will be made once grant funds are received. Appropriations To Other Funds at 64%. This is directly related to street maintenance projects, as well as Local Street Fund operations.
- Major Street Fund: Revenues and Expenditures at 77% Street maintenance projects:
 Highway, Streets and Bridges at 42%. Budgeted projects (street paving and crack sealing) started in June. Expenses will be posted back to June once paid.
 Surface Maintenance at 68%. Pavement striping completed in June. Expenses will be posted back to June once paid.
- 3. <u>Local Street Fund:</u> Revenues and Expenditures at 77% Street maintenance projects: Surface Maintenance at 64%. Pavement striping completed in June. Expenses will be posted back to June once paid.

Cash Summary Report

The Cash Summary report shows the cash activity for the month of June. Notable items are as follows:

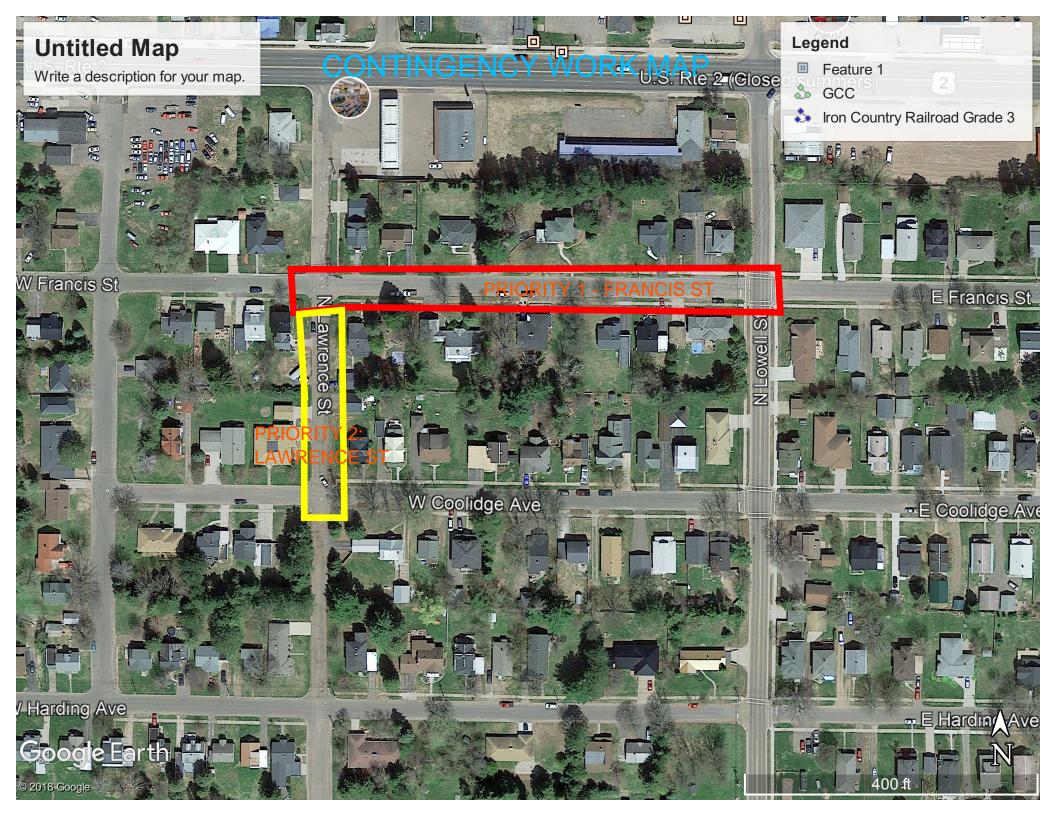

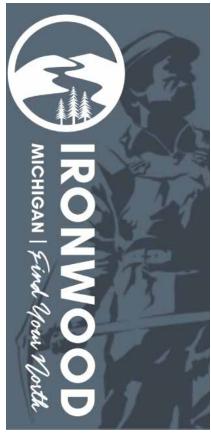

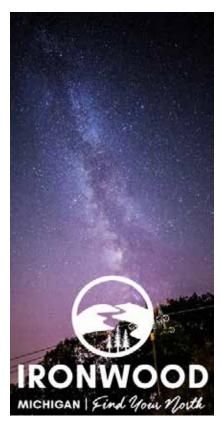
