Dear Fellow Alumni,

Lillian Thompson died in May 1972, shortly after celebrating her 91<sup>st</sup> birthday. She never married and outlived nearly all of her relatives, leaving only two family survivors and the South Otselic Central School Alumni Association (and perhaps other civic groups) to inherit her modest estate. She had taught English at SOCS for 30+ years and had an lasting love of the area children and an understanding of the economic struggles many of those children to attend college. Thus, the Lillian Thompson Alumni Scholarship Fund was established in 1972. Funds were collected from alumni for ten years and added to the funds from the Thompson estate. The first scholarship was awarded in 1982. In the past 41 years alumni have continued to generously make annual donations, helping the scholarship fund grow. June Cole Wood Rose, another long time SOCS teacher, bequeathed a generous amount from her trust fund upon her death. And many alumni have contributed to the fund on an annual basis.

Originally, only one deserving alumni received the scholarship each year. The dollar amount varied, as only the interest was given away. That insured that the fund could grow as long as contributions were received. Federal legislation now require that a certain percentage of the fund be awarded each year. It is considerably larger than is earned from interest, and several awards are given each year. So without the continued generous support of current alumni, this wonderful scholarship fund will eventually disappear.
