## ADOPT A MEMORIAL BRICK

The Veterans Freedom Memorial Brick Program is a way for everyone to take part in the continued expansion and addition to the Veterans Freedom Memorial, POW/MIA Memorial, WW II Submarine Veterans Memorial and adjacent walkways on the grounds of the Veterans Memorial Park, 3602 US 301 North at the Tampa Bay-Pass Canal.

This six column memorial, constructed of white Georgia marble, is the largest multi-column Veterans memorial in the state and the only one to recognize all five branches of the service, and their involvement in the cause of freedom since the birth of this nation. These bricks will be used to pave new and existing walkways in the Veterans Memorial Park.

Through the program, each brick will be available for a \$35 tax-free, tax-deductible contribution.

Each brick you order will be engraved to your specifications. The engraving must be no more than three lines, with up to fourteen characters per line, including spacing. You can personalize your brick with a person's name. Refer to samples below. There are endless possibilities. Each brick must contain a last name for directory purposes, with no more than one name per brick. When possible, bricks ordered together will stay together in the park. A directory has been developed to make locating your brick easier.

This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to be part of this projects. Your purchase of a Memorial Brick, inscribed with a person's name, will be your way of saying "Thank you for the freedom that I enjoy today. You will not be forgotten."
