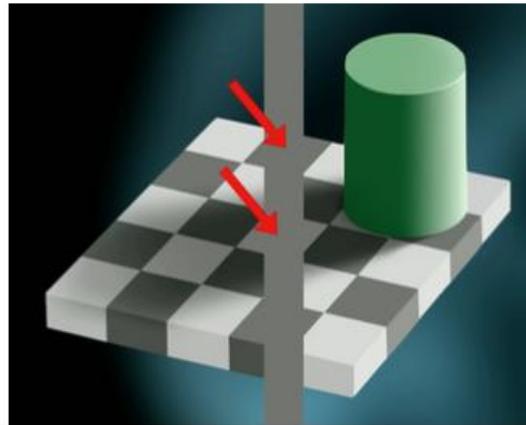
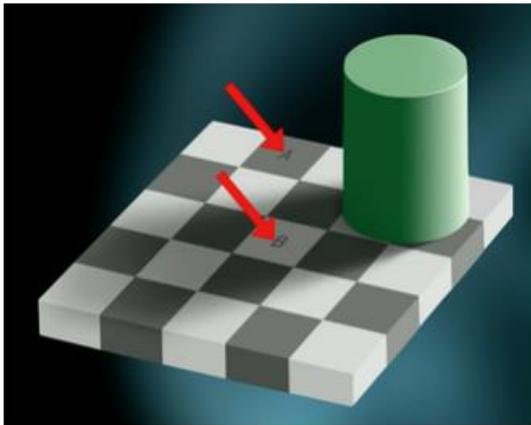
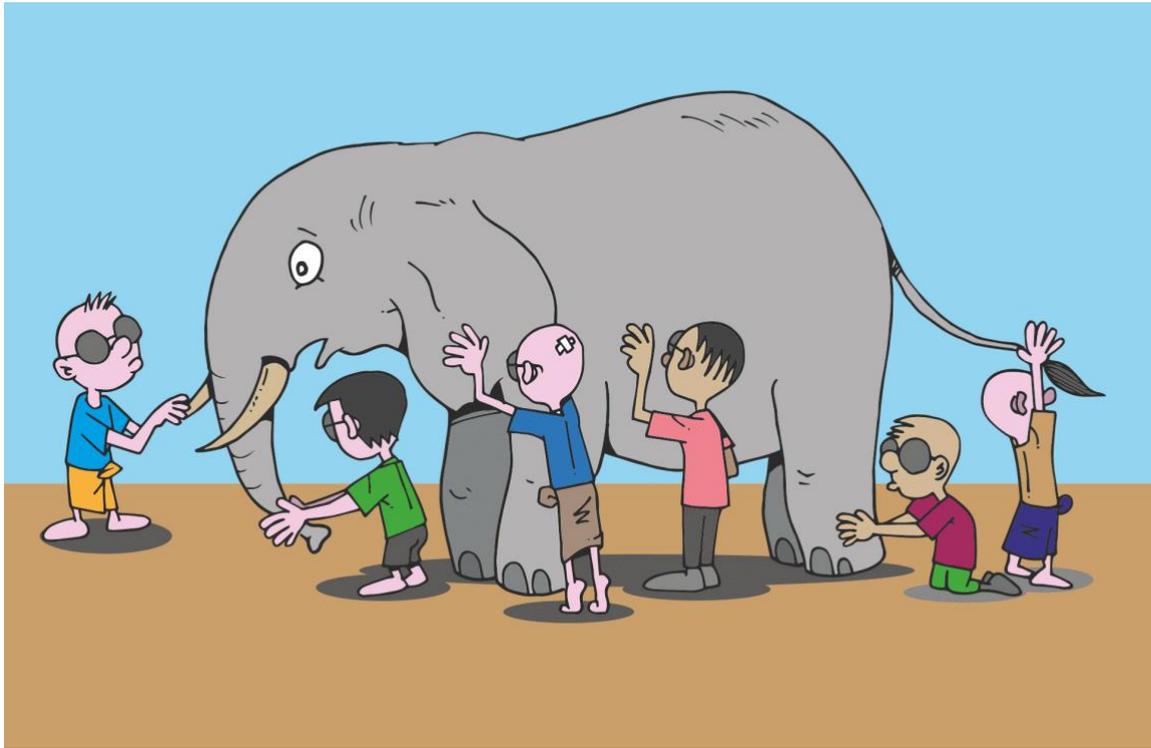


The Problem of Perception



Main Takeaways

- **unreliable** (e.g. illusions and dreams)
- **different** to the world experienced by others (e.g. the taste of coriander)
- **always limited** by having a partial perspective (like the blind people with the elephant)
