Re: 2014-008 City of Ironwood Comprehensive Plan

Before the Commission this evening is a resolution to adopt the City of Ironwood's new Comprehensive Plan. The plan can be found at <a href="http://ironwoodcompplan.com/documents/COMPPLANDRAFT\_062514.pdf">http://ironwoodcompplan.com/documents/COMPPLANDRAFT\_062514.pdf</a> The plan and supporting appendices outline the City's long range goals, policies and strategies to direct the City into a new chapter in its history. The plan outlines a number of strategies and programs to implement that will create an environment and new opportunities to encourage existing residents and businesses to continue to call Ironwood its home and attract new residents and businesses.

As outlined in Appendix B, there was a significant effort to engage the public in the planning process. The plan is an accumulation of that public input process as well as input from you, the Planning Commission, City Commission and other boards and commissions of the City of Ironwood. You should be proud of your accomplishment and should celebrate the plan through its energetic implementation.

Staff recommends approving Resolution 2014-024 which adopts the Comprehensive Plan.

#### **RESOLUTION #2014-024**

#### **Ironwood Comprehensive Plan**

WHEREAS, the Michigan Planning Enabling Act (MPEA), PA 33 of 2008, provides that the Planning Commission may prepare a Master Plan for the use, development, and preservation of all lands in the City; and

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the requirements of the MPEA, the Planning Commission notified contiguous government jurisdictions as well as other interested or affected agencies, for purposes of notification, of its intent to prepare and adopt an update to its Comprehensive Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Comprehensive Plan was submitted to the City Commission on April 14, 2014, who authorized distribution of the proposed plan; and

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the requirements of the MPEA, the proposed Comprehensive Plan was distributed on April 15, 2014 to contiguous government jurisdictions as well as other interested or affected agencies for review and comment; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 2, 2014, after proper public notice, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed Comprehensive Plan update, during which members of the public were given the opportunity to comment on the proposed plan and written comments received were presented and discussed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission has determined that the draft of the Comprehensive Plan reflects the long range vision for the City and charts an implementation framework towards achieving that vision.

**THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the Ironwood Planning Commission hereby approves, adopts, and recommends the approval of the Comprehensive Plan update, as per requirements of the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, PA 33 of 2008.



Re: 2014-007 Little League Field Conditional Use and Site Plan Review

Before the Commission is a request from the Ironwood Area Softball League for a conditional use permit and site plan review of a proposed softball field, restrooms/concession stand and accessory uses to the field. The property is owned by the City of Ironwood and is zoned O-Open Area District and is approximately 25 acres in size; the field is off of Vaughn St. south of Huron St. The proposed uses are consistent with the purpose of the District and Comprehensive Plan.


Since the submission of the application and legal notices published and mailed, it has come to the City's attention it is not required to comply with its Zoning Ordinance if the property is owned by the City; this was confirmed by attorney Pope. Therefore, no official action by the Planning Commission is required. A public hearing has been scheduled and will be held, but it will be for informational purposes only.

In addition, the Plan will be reviewed by the Parks and Recreation Committee.










# PC Case 2014-007 Little League Field




Re: 2014-006 Surplus Property Purchase Request
